Modern geopolitical and domestic challenges determine relevance of language policy and linguistic security for Russia. The search for cutting edge solutions and building innovative models that will ensure the country’s linguistic security requires joint liability from the government and other political and social institutions that are responsible for the future of the country. - International Collaboration in Teaching Foreign Languages.
- Linguistic Presentation of Migration and Integration.
- Political, Social and Religious Discourses as Areas for Cross-cultural Communication.
